Resolution 9	As per the Section 5.1 of the WBJEE Bulletin, published on 17 th October, 2019, the private self-financing institutes have the sole right to decide the number of reserved category seats to be admitted through the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations. Referring to this notification issued by the WBJEE Board, the Member Secretary provided the details of the Department specific reserved seat details as shown in Annexure - I. The reserved seats were allocated in such a way so that it doesn't exceed the 10% of the Total Intake. The Board of Governors approved this proposal.

Additionally, the Board delegated authority to the principal; to maintain the faculty count in line with the sanctioned positions, in consultation with the BoG.



5.1.1 Competent Authorities for the issuance of SC/ST Certificate for candidates claiming under such reserve category of seats SC/ST Certificates are to be issued by any of the following authorities: Sub-Divisional Officers for all districts except Kolkata (ii) District Welfare Officer, Kolkata & Ex-Officio Ioint Director, B.C.W. in case of Kolkata Municipal Area (as defined in clause (9) of Section 2 of K.M.C Act, 1980 Competent Authorities for the issuance of OBC-A / OBC-B Certificate 5.1.2 for candidates claiming under such reserve category of seats: As per Notification vide No. 374(71)-TW/EC/MR-103/94 27/7/1994, read with Memorandum No. 1204-SBCW/MR-67/10 dated 27/7/2015 issued by Backward Classes Welfare Department. Govt. of W.B., the Sub Divisional Officer of a Sub- Division in a District is the certificate issuing authority. In Kolkata such certificate is issued by such an officer as the State Government by modification authorizes. Accordingly, the District Welfare Officer, Kolkata and Ex-officio Joint Director, BCW has been notified to act as the certificate issuing authority in respect of Kolkata covering the jurisdiction of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation. 5.1.3 Reservation of seats for PwD candidates Reservation will be available for candidates with 40% to 70% disabilities of following types, subject to the condition that the candidate can carry out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to B.E/B. Tech/B. Arch/B. Pharm courses without any special concession and exemption. A. Locomotor disability B. Visual Impairment C. Hearing impairment D. Speech and language disability In addition to the above four types, if any candidate of any other type of disability claim for PwD reservation, his/her admission in PwD category will be decided solely by the concerned institution/University. PwD certificates are to be issued by any of the following authorities Officer-in-Charge/ Head of Department/ Head of the institute of Sub-Divisional Hospitals, District Hospitals, Govt. Medical Colleges run by the Govt. of West Bengal. Special concessions to PwD candidates 5.1.3.1 a) PwD candidates are eligible for 40% reduction on application fees. To avail the same, the candidate must formally apply in writing (enclosing

- b) PwD candidates are entitled for 20 minutes extra time in each paper, for which the candidate must sit for the examination in the Board's office in Kolkata. To avail the concession, the candidate must formally apply in writing (enclosing a copy of his/her confirmation page and PwD certificate) to the Chairman, WBJEEB and send/submit the application to the Board office by 31.01.2020.
- c) Visually impaired PwD candidates are entitled to use a scribe/writer having less/lower academic qualification than the candidate. Highest qualification of such scribe/writer will be passed/appeared in 10th standard examination in 2020. To avail such facility, the candidate must sit for the examination in the Board's office in Kolkata. The candidate must formally apply in writing (enclosing a copy of his/her confirmation page and PwD certificate) to the Chairman, WBJEEB and send/submit the application to the Board office by 31.01.2020.
- d) The Board's decision in this regard will be final and binding on the candidate.

Reservation of Seats for admission of the wards of Defense Personnel (Defense Quota Seats)

As per the Govt. Order vide No. 406(T), Dated, 09.06.2016 of the Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal 13(thirteen) seats are available for admission of the wards of Defense Personnel through WBJEE-2020.

Those seats are supernumerary in nature and separate allotment is done by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board as per the following guidelines:

- A. For consideration under Defense Quota, intending candidates registered for the WBJEE-2020 will **have to apply** to the Rajya Sainik Board, Home Department, Government of West Bengal, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata 700001 through the concerned Zila Sainik Board, W.B. (for ex-servicemen) and Units (for serving soldiers) in the prescribed form with an attested copy of WBJEE 2020 Admit Card.
- B. Based on the recommendation of the said Rajya Sainik Board, a separate list shall be published by the WBJEEB for subsequent offline counselling and allotment of seats inter-se merit basis. Securing a General Merit Rank (GMR) is mandatory for such category of seat.
- C. Allotment of seats under Defense Quota is not through ecounseling.
- D. Institution-wise and course-wise availability of such seats under Defense Quota for 2018 is given below. List for 2020 shall be published before counseling.
